DISCUSSION REGARDING PARKING IN VILLAGE MUNICIPAL LOTS AT THE VILLAGE HALL COMPLEX, AQUATIC CENTER AND ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF MORSE AVENUE ADJACENT TO PROESEL PARK

Purpose of Discussion

- The Village has existing language in the Village Code regarding parking restrictions in the Village Hall Complex Municipal Parking Lot
- Further language is needed for clarification of restricted parking spaces and time limits for vehicles not conducting Village business or attending Village events
- Aquatic Center Parking is restricted only overnight and needs further clarification/restriction during periods of operation
- Restricted parking along the north side of Morse Avenue is only clarified in the Public Parks section of the Code regarding park hours. This restriction needs to be addressed in the appropriate restricted parking section of the Code.

Current Village Code for the Municipal Lot at the Village Hall Complex

7-2-16 (B)

Within the municipal parking lot located between Village Hall on the east, Proesel Park on the west, Morse Avenue on the south, and Lincoln Avenue on the north, it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to park in the lot between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. at any time, unless:

- 1) The driver or occupant of the vehicle is a Village employee;
- 2) The driver or occupant of the vehicle is on Village business at the Village Hall Complex; or
- 3) The driver or occupant of the vehicle is on business at or is using the Village Community Center.

Village Hall Complex Municipal Parking Lot



Proposed Language for the Municipal Lot at the Village Hall Complex

The Village Hall Municipal Parking Lot will restrict parking of any vehicle for not more than two hours in the lot at any given time, and it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to park between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. at any time, unless:

- 1) The driver or occupant of the vehicle is a Village employee and in compliance with posted signage for designated spaces;
- 2) The driver or occupant of the vehicle is on Village business at the Village Hall Complex and in compliance with posted signage for designated spaces; or
- 3) The driver or occupant of the vehicle is on business at or is using the Village Community Center in compliance with posted signage for designated spaces.

Current Code for the Aquatic Center Parking Lot at 7000 N. Kostner Avenue

Public Parks 6-3-2

(B)

No person shall be or remain in Henry A. Proesel Park between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on the following day, each and every day of the year.

(C)

Vehicular parking. No vehicle may be parked in any parking lot used for Lincolnwood Centennial Park or Henry A. Proesel Park Family Aquatic Center during the hours during which such park is closed, as set forth in Sections 6-3-2(A) and 6-3-2(B) of this Code,

Aquatic Center Parking Lot



Proposed Language for Parking at the Aquatic Center Parking Lot

The Aquatic Center municipal parking lot will prohibit parking of vehicles overnight from 11pm to 6am.

Additionally, any vehicle at anytime parked in violation of posted signage restricting parking within the Aquatic Center lot and from Memorial Day thru Labor Day, parking from 6am to 11pm parking will be restricted for patrons, employees or others having Aquatic Center business at the Lincolnwood Aquatic Center.

Current Code Language Restricting Parking along Morse Avenue adjacent to Proesel Park

6-3-2 Public Parks

Vehicular parking. No vehicle may be parked in any parking lot used for Lincolnwood Centennial Park or Henry A. Proesel Park Family Aquatic Center during the hours during which such park is closed, as set forth in Sections 6-3-2(A) and 6-3-2(B) of this Code.

Morse Avenue adjacent to Proesel Park



Recommended Code Language to be consistent with Kostner Avenue

7-2-15

(B) Between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.:

Kostner Avenue, on the east side thereof, between Morse & Estes

Suggested Addition for Morse Avenue:

(K) Between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.:

Morse Avenue, on the north side thereof, between Kostner &
80 feet to the east of Kildare Avenue.
