**1. Department Services overview: Police Department,**

Community Development Director Scott Mangum gave a presentation regarding the number of cannabis dispensaries allowed in the Village.

Public Works Director Nadim Badran gave a presentation on the Village's current practices and procedures regarding alley maintenance and related policy issues. He also discussed the potential for "green alleys" that could be utilized for stormwater management in the coming years

*Due to time constraints, this Closed Session will be held after the Regular Village Board meeting.*


**Adjournment**
