
## Utility Location

It is **ILLINOIS STATE LAW** that requires you to notify **J.U.L.I.E.** (Joint Utility Locating Information for Excavators) at least two but not more than 14 business days before any digging project regardless of project size or depth. This is to verify location of underground utilities in the area. The service is provided to you at no charge.

When calling J.U.L.I.E at either 811 or 1-800-892-0123, the following information about the proposed work location will be requested: county, township, section number, and quarter section. This information can be obtained from the legal description on your plat of survey. You can also go directly to their website at <https://www.illinois1call.com/> to submit an E-Request.



Know and understand the different **flag colors**. J.U.L.I.E member companies use the following color coded flags and paint to mark their underground facilities.



The **Tolerance Zone** is a pre-defined horizontal distance extending from the outer edge of a line or pipe that runs underground. The exact distance that defines this tolerance zone is 18" on either side of the line or pipe (utility) plus the diameter of the line or pipe itself.

The tolerance zone acts as a warning to an excavator that they need to proceed with caution while working in this area.

Excavators should hand dig, pot hole or vacuum excavate within the tolerance zone.
