

**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ENCOURAGING THE USE OF
FACE COVERINGS WHILE IN PUBLIC PARKS
MADE PURSUANT TO THE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
VILLAGE OF LINCOLNWOOD
NOVEMBER 19, 2020**

I, Mayor Barry I. Bass, do hereby issue the following supplemental emergency order for the Village of Lincolnwood this 19th day of November, 2020 ("**Supplemental Order**").

Introduction

On March 18, 2020, I issued a Declaration of Emergency pursuant to the authority granted to me by: Section 5-6-2 of the Municipal Code of Lincolnwood, as amended ("**Village Code**"); Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6; and Section 11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11 to address the health threat posed by the COVID-19 pandemic ("**Declaration**").

The Declaration granted and reserved emergency powers to the Mayor during the pendency of the civil emergency, including the right to issue additional emergency regulations and orders in furtherance of the Declaration.

Since issuance of the Declaration, the corporate authorities of the Village of Lincolnwood have, on several occasions, approved and extended the duration of the Declaration, including the extension made at the Village Board meeting on November 17, 2020, which extended the Declaration to December 1, 2020.

Pursuant to the Declaration, as extended, I have, from time-to-time, issued emergency orders in an effort to address and mitigate the health threat posed by the pandemic in the Village of Lincolnwood, many of which orders remain in full force and effect, including the April 23, 2020 Supplemental Order requiring the use of face coverings while engaging in public and unable to practice social distancing ("**Face Covering Supplemental Order**"); and

Section C of the Face Covering Supplemental Order exempted outdoor activities from the requirements of wearing face coverings, which outdoor activities include activities in public parks.

In Executive Order No. 2020-63, issued on October 27, 2020, Governor Pritzker directed the closure of certain business activities, and ordered limitations be placed on meetings, gatherings, and other social events for the purposes of mitigating the spread of COVID-19 in, among other places, suburban Cook County ("**Mitigation Order**").

In Executive Order No. 2020-71, issued on November 13, 2020, Governor Pritzker entered a new order, renewing and extending the Mitigation Order through December 12, 2020.

In the Tier 3 Resurgence Mitigations effective on November 20, 2020, the State mandated that face coverings shall be required for all organized group recreational activities at all times.

In light of the rapid increase in COVID-19 cases in the Village of Lincolnwood and the surrounding area, I have determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to issue a supplemental emergency order as set forth below, encouraging residents to use face coverings while in public parks.

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the Village, and to further protect the residents of the Village from disease and death, and pursuant to the authority set forth in the Declaration, Sections 11-1-6 and 11-20-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6, 11-20-5; and Section 11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11, I find that it is necessary to issue a supplemental emergency order as set forth below.

Supplemental Order

A. Use of Face Coverings in Public Parks. All persons over the age of two are encouraged to wear face coverings while in a public park within the corporate limits of the Village of Lincolnwood, particularly when they are not able to maintain social and physical distancing in accordance with the state's Mitigation Order.

B. Type of Face Coverings. For purpose of this Supplemental Order, face coverings shall cover their nose and mouth and shall be made of cloth or other material that is reasonably designed and made to inhibit, filter, or restrict the breath, sneeze, cough, or other exhaling from one's nose and mouth.


C. Medical-grade Masks. Medical-grade masks and N95 respirators are not recommended for general public use under this Supplemental Order, and should be reserved for use by health care and medical providers and first responders.

The intent of this Supplemental Order is to further increase the wearing of face coverings when in public to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus, and to protect essential workers and all members of our community. Nothing in this Supplemental Order shall supersede or relieve any person from complying with the social distancing requirements or other health guidelines set forth in the Mitigation Order. Social and physical distancing is still the first and most effective practice to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

This Supplemental Order will take effect on Thursday November 19, 2020 at 11:59 pm, and run concurrently with the term of the Declaration of Civil Emergency unless rescinded or superseded by my order or a majority vote of the corporate authorities at any regular or emergency meeting thereof.
